- Must be at least 21 years of age.

Responsibilities:

- Oversee all aspects of the medical requirements at camp including: Health Forms, ICPS, Medications, Allergies, State Paperwork.
- This position requires paperwork/emails that must be handled outside of the normal camp season.
- Use the Standing Orders provided by the Camp Physician to apply first aid or seek additional medical assistance.
- Ensure the safety of all campers especially those with health concerns.
- Proper documentation and reporting of all health related occurrences at camp.
- Safely store and organize all medications.
- Ensure that all Coaches are aware of any concerns and have signed appropriate ICPs for their given campers.
- Take primary responsibility for the health, well-being, and happiness of campers.
- Encourage respect for campers, personal property, camp equipment, facilities.
- Set a good example of campers in all areas, including cleanliness, punctuality, rules, and sportsmanship.
- Observe camper behavior, assess its appropriateness, and apply appropriate behavior management techniques.
- Actively participate in pre-camp training and scheduled staff meetings outside of normal camp season.
